

Each year we have two solemn feasts that follow the Sundays after the Feast of Pentecost and the Easter Season. The first is the Solemn Feast of The Most Holy Trinity and the second is Corpus Christi or the Feast of the Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Both feasts give us time to reflect on Almighty God. The most Holy Trinity is the central focus of our faith. Our belief in one God in Three divine persons.


share the divine life and love that God has given to us in the Most Holy Eucharist

The goal is to fill nearly 50 10m3 oxygen tanks daily to help fill an urgent need in the community.
