


Due to the Election Day on November 3rd, we will hold a Zoom meeting on November 3rd. Vivat Jesu!

WHY THE KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS ???

During the long summer of 2020, when scores of statues of Christopher Columbus have been vandalized or removed around the United States, it is important to remember why those statues were erected.

Above all it had to do with the possibility of building in the Western hemisphere a new civilization — one that would bring together European traditions and ideas with the Native American peoples, traditions and the flora and fauna of the new continent.

The first members of the Knights of Columbus were influenced by this vision and also instrumental in promoting it. Just two years after the death of the Knights' founder, Father Michael McGivney, councils enthusiastically participated in the first national Columbus Day, declared in 1892 for the quadricentennial of the great navigator's landing. For them and many others, Columbus was celebrated as a figure of civic unity and a symbol that immigrants, particularly Catholics, possessed a rightful share in American identity.

A MESSAGE FROM OUR CHAPLAIN

Brother Knights,

October is the month of the Rosary, as we celebrate the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary on October 7, 2020. October also is Respect Life Month, when we pray for the protection of all life, especially the most vulnerable, the sick, suffering, dying, the child in the womb, and all life created in the image and likeness of God. (see Genesis 1:26) The solemn



prayer of the Holy Rosary and Respect Life is foundational to the identity of the Knights of Columbus. So much so that we could say October is also Knights of Columbus Month, a month to stand firm in our commitment to defend and protect life and deepen our prayer life. Knights commit to pray the Rosary and incorporate the mysteries of the Rosary, that is, the Life of Christ into our hearts, lives, and souls.

We need to have a greater urgency to deepen our prayer lives as we see our society turning away from the Lord more and more each day. We need to pray for those who cannot pray for themselves, the unborn, the unbeliever, the unchurched, and all those who have no one to pray for them. When we say that we are for life, it must be even for our enemies, as the Lord says, "Love your enemies, and pray for those who persecute you, that you may be children of your heavenly Father." (Matt 5:44b – 45a)

My first-grade teacher, Sister Marie Clare, is one of my lifelong heroes. I went to give her Last Rites, Anointing of the Sick, and Holy Communion just before she died last year. A once towering Sister, to a first-grader, she laid there frail and weak in the eyes of the world. But her faith in the Lord is what made her strong even amid imminent death. Lying on her death bed, with all the strength she could muster, she said to me, "William,

we need to pray for everyone." Sr. Marie Clare's prophetic words of wisdom are powerful and have become so true during our time. Pray the Holy Rosary, pray that all may Respect Life, and pray for everyone.
