COLUMBUS CHAPEL PROJECT

In 2004 the Pennsylvania State Council Knights of Columbus recommitted to assist in the preservation of an important historical facility in Pennsylvania – the Columbus Chapel in Boalsburg, Pennsylvania. Discussions and planning began with chapel officials to formulate planned assistance to the site and to engage the state council and individual councils to provide assistance to the Columbus family chapel. At that time a four phase plans was agreed upon.

Phase I – replace the walkway leading to the chapel to make it safer.

Phase II – construct a walkway/sitting area with inscribed stones of statewide councils

Phase III – install two lamp posts to illuminate the walkway and the chapel

Phase IV – painting and other exterior work to the Columbus Chapel building

With the donations from 21 councils, one chapter, and the state council budget, Phase I has been completed. Money is now being solicited for Phase II of the project.

Councils interested in participating in Phase II by purchasing an inscribed stone with a council number and name/town are asked to complete the attached form. Additionally, individuals may also purchase a stone for themselves or in memory of another person.
