## A MESSAGE FROM THE CHAPTER PRESIDENT

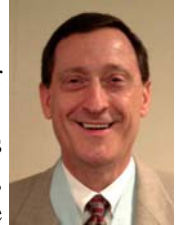
My Brother Knights:
