NEW ROMAN MISSAL



The implementation of the new 3rd Edition Roman Missal will take place on the **first Sunday of Advent in 2011, Nov. 27.**

The Roman Missal is the liturgical book containing the texts, readings and prayers recited in the celebration of the Mass. The main reason for the changes being made is that in 2000, Pope John Paul II thought that as the new millennium began it would be a good time to have a new Roman Missal.

What does that mean to you as a parishioner? Mostly it will mean some changes in the responses for the congregation during the mass. The clergy will have some "re-learning" of the rubrics of the mass.

Each parish will be responsible to inform their parishioners on the changes prior to their implementation on November 27.
