
The weather is starting to show signs of Spring, and

Pope to Patriarch Kirill: May we become peacemakers for Ukraine!

"Dear Brother! May the Holy Spirit transform our hearts and make us true peacemakers, especially for war-torn Ukraine, so that the great Easter passage from death to new life in Christ may become a reality for the Ukrainian people, who long for a new dawn that will end the darkness of war."

Pope Francis penned those words to the head of the Russian Orthodox Church, Patriarch Kirill, as Christians who follow the Julian calendar celebrated Easter on Sunday.

The Pope's brief letter of Easter greetings was sent also to other Patriarchs of Eastern Churches, and was published on the Moscow Patriarchate's website.

SEMINARIAN UPDATE

Three seminarians will be ordained to the transitional diaconate June 4th, marking a major milestone on their journey to the priesthood.

The Mass of ordination to the transitional diaconate will be livestreamed June 4th, 10 a.m., https://diopitt.org/. More information follows.

On June 4, 2022, there will be a Mass during which three Seminarians of the Pittsburgh Diocese will become transitional deacons. Since the Knights play an important role in supporting Seminarians, Color Corp has been requested for the event. This is an especially important event, three of the Diocese's Bishops will be presiding over the Mass, and six to seven hundred people will be in attendance. The Mass will be at St. Thomas the Apostle Parish, at the St. Therese of Lisieux Worship Site in Munhall at 10:00 am. Because of the expected turnout, we will need to provide a list of attendees to the coordinator. All are welcome at the Mass and complementary full reception after the Mass, so Knights are welcome to bring their Ladies and family with them. They would just need to provide names for the RSVP list. The Pastor is also looking for assistance with directing parking, if any of the Brother Knights from area Councils or Assemblies would prefer to help with that task. Reporting time would be 8:30 am to assist with parking and 9:00 am to participate in the Color Corp.

ASCENSION THURSDAY - MAY 26, 2022

Ascension Day is the celebration of Christ ascending into heaven after His death, burial and resurrection. Ascension Day is observed primarily in Catholic and Anglican churches, and it occurs on the Thursday 40 days after Easter. Ascension Day is also called the Feast of Ascension.

The story of Jesus' Ascension is told in Luke 24:50-53, Mark 16:19 and Acts 1:3, 9. Putting these accounts together, we find that after His resurrection, Jesus appeared several times to His disciples and others. During this time, He spoke to them further about the kingdom of God and the coming of the Holy Spirit, for whom they were to wait (Acts 1:2-9). After 40 days of these appearances, He was taken up to heaven for the last time (Acts 1:9-11). As the disciples watched Him go, two angels appeared and declared to them that, just as He ascended, Jesus would return in glory. Ascension Day is a Holy Day of Obligation.
